

# General and Vocational Qualification Fees 2022/23

Effective period: 1 September 2022 to 31 August 2023



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This document summarises the WJEC CBAC and WJEC Eduqas Entry Fees for 2022/23 from 1 September 2022. It should be noted that all Entry and Registration Fees apply from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 and assume that there is no change in what aspects of service are paid for by government.

To assist in reading this document, the Entry Fees for general and vocational qualifications are grouped and listed by subject. Where unit entry is allowable, the unit entry fee is also provided. If the qualification has a double award or short course entry option, the respective double award and short course entry fees are also provided.

## 2.0 What do WJEC CBAC and Eduqas fees include?

This section details the processes followed by WJEC in relation to invoicing centres for Entry Fees.

### 3.1 Issuing of Invoices

WJEC will issue invoices for each qualification as follows:

- On time entries will be invoiced at the end of the amendment window
- Late fees will be invoiced after the date on which very late fees are applied.
- Very late fees will be invoiced after the closing date for late Cash-Ins

Generally, invoices will be issued within 4 weeks of the above deadlines.

Invoices will be emailed to the centre contact using the confirmed email address held by WJEC's Finance Department.

### 3.2 Invoice Content

On time invoices will provide a breakdown of fees by qualification/unit, including unit price and quantity. For late and very late fees, the invoice will also provide detail of the candidates.

Each invoice will be allocated a unique invoice number and will provide clear details of the fee being charged,

### 3.3 Payment Terms

WJEC payment terms are 21 days from the date of the invoice. If full payment is not received by this date, WJEC will instigate its standard credit control processes to collect overdue debts.

### 3.4 Payment of Invoices

Invoices should be settled by either bank transfer or cheque, and details of these methods of payment are included on each invoice.

### 3.5 Retention of Invoices

Invoices are retained for the previous complete six financial years plus the current financial year in accordance with legal requirements on the retention of records.

## 4.1 Late, Very Late Entries and Registrations

Centres must submit their entries (and registrations) in an accurate and timely way, to ensure that WJEC is able to provide correct examination and assessment materials and issue examination results on time. WJEC actively encourages centres to submit their entries on time to avoid incurring additional work and cost at WJEC and subsequent cost to themselves in the form of late fees and to allow sufficient time for centres' own self-review.

Entry Deadlines for all 2022/23 qualifications are detailed in **4.1a**, along with the Amendment Window and dates from which Late Fees and Very Late Fees will apply. The table below provides key information on entry terminology:

### Terminology

<b>Entry</b>	Candidate is correctly entered with appropriate personal details, qualification entry code and subject/unit entry code information (and Cash-In code where applicable) and entry complies with the related entry rules. A submission that does not have the appropriate information included and that does not comply with the entry rules is incorrect and will be rejected.
<b>Entry Deadline</b>	The final date that entries can be received and processed by WJEC without incurring additional charges.
<b>Amendment Window</b>	The period when centres can make amendments to entries at no additional cost.
<b>Amendment Date</b>	The date by which all amendments to entries must be submitted, to ensure no additional charges will be applied.
<b>Entry Fee</b>	The Entry Fee indicated for the specific qualification or unit.
<b>Late Fee Date</b>	The date from which all entries and amendments will incur a Late Fee charge. The Late Fee is equivalent to 2 times the Entry Fee for that qualification (or unit).
<b>Very Late Fee Date</b>	The date from which all entries and amendments will incur a Very Late Fee charge. The Very Late Fee is equivalent to 2.5 times the Entry Fee for that qualification (or unit).

Centres should be aware that WJEC may refuse late and very late entries for some qualifications if there is a risk to the integrity and security of the examination or assessment delivery or to the processing of timely results.

## 4.2 Amendments

### Non-chargeable Amendments

- Centres can change the personal details for candidates entered for WJEC qualifications up to the Certificate Printing Deadlines outlined below, at no additional charge.

### Chargeable Amendments

- If a centre submits a qualification or unit change (amendment) related to the following outside the amendment window:
  - Tier**
  - Subject**
- The centre will be charged a fee equivalent to the Late Fee or Very Late Fee (less the standard fee already paid), depending on when the late amendment is made. For example, an amendment made on 24<sup>th</sup> October to the tier or subject of an entry for a November series GCSE would be deemed a Late Entry and would generate an additional standard entry fee charge. Similarly, if an amendment was made as late as 1<sup>st</sup> November, this would be deemed a Very Late Entry and would generate an additional amendment fee equivalent to one and half times the standard entry fee.
- If candidate personal details are amended after the Certificate Printing Deadlines (indicated above), a £10 charge will be applied, to reflect the additional time and materials required to issue a revised certificate. Please note that personal details may only be amended via this route up to 12 months after certificate issue. If centres wish to amend personal details after this date, they will need to follow the replacement certificate process outlined on WJEC's public website.

### 4.3 Late Cash-In (Aggregation) Fee

Where required, centres should include the appropriate Cash-In code for a qualification when submitting their entries to WJEC. If a Cash-In code is subsequently submitted by the Amendment Date, then no additional charge will apply. If the Cash-In code is submitted after the Amendment Date, the following fees will apply:

- Cymraeg Gwaith / Work Welsh

### 4.4 Entry Withdrawal

If centres withdraw a candidate, subject or unit after the amendment date, in most cases the entry fee will not be refunded.

Where centres are waiting on candidate examination results for the January series in order to decide whether those candidates also need to be entered for the summer series examinations, centres must enter **all possible candidates** by the entry deadline for the summer series. Centres can then withdraw candidates, as required, during the amendment window, once January examination results are published early in March: in these circumstances, the entry fee will not be charged.

Where a candidate is unable to sit an examination due to ill health or bereavement and a centre communicates this formally to WJEC within 2 weeks of the examination date (along with an accompanying medical certificate for ill health cases), WJEC may refund the candidate entry fee. Eligibility for refund will be considered on a case by case basis.

In situations where candidates are deceased prior to an examination sitting, the centre should provide a formal letter communicating this to WJEC so that we can respond appropriately in relation to the fee refund and other matters.

### 4.5 Transfer of Candidates

Where a candidate is entered for an examination at one centre and then needs to take the examination at an alternative UK or Non-UK centre\*, the following fees will apply:

#### Transfer fees

Candidates sitting examinations at UK centres	£30.00
Candidates sitting examinations outside of the UK	£60.00

\*Please note that the centre must also meet the relevant JCQ requirements for transfer candidates.

### 4.6 Centres with Subjects Requiring Examiner or Moderator Visits

WJEC arranges travel and accommodation (where necessary) for examiners/moderators to enable the visit to take place. Therefore centres are advised that any requests to change the arranged date within 10 working days of the visit may incur charges that are equivalent to the travel and accommodation costs incurred by the organisation.

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### 5.1 GCSEs where whole units were not assessed in 2022

Qualifications Wales announced on 13 May 2022 that GCSE, AS and A level adaptations made for the 2022 exams will not apply in 2023. However, advance information of the focus of the 2023 assessments will be provided in early February 2023 to help students prioritise their revision.

Students who sat adapted WJEC GCSE qualifications in 2022 will, if they wish to resit any of these qualifications in 2023, be required to take assessments as shown in the relevant specification (i.e. without any adaptations). Students resitting exams in 2023 will take the same exam paper as students sitting for the first time. There will not be a separate paper for resitting candidates based on streamlined assessment content for summer 2022.

However, we recognise there are particular issues for resitters of WJEC GCSE qualifications where one or more whole units were removed from the 2022 assessments. WJEC has agreed with Qualifications Wales that resitters of any of the WJEC GCSE qualifications listed in the following table will not be required to sit all units in 2023. They may, if they wish, retake only the units they sat in 2022 and not the unit(s) listed below which were removed from assessment in 2022.

For students resitting these qualifications only, the weightings applied to each unit will be the amended weightings from summer 2022 (taking account of the reduction in units) rather than the weightings for the whole qualification given in the specification. The amended weightings are given in Appendix A of the WJEC [GCSE adaptations booklet](#) for summer 2022 which remains available on the WJEC website.

A terminal rule will apply against the adapted weightings, apart from in GCSE English Literature where the rule was suspended in 2022, and will be suspended for students resitting this qualification in 2023.

**It is important to note these arrangements apply only to cash-in students from summer 2022 resitting the qualifications listed above in 2023.** They do not apply to qualifications where there was another form of adaptation, e.g. one task/section was removed, or topics were removed from the assessment in 2022.

All entry fees will remain at the standard fee for that qualification regardless of the adapted assessment arrangements in place. For candidates resitting the above subjects from Summer 2022, the applicable entry option, and cash-in for unitised qualifications should be selected.

### 5.2 Summer 2023: Unitised A Level qualification rules

Please refer to our document Summer 2023: Unitised A Level qualification rules to check in what circumstances learners only need to resit A2 units ([available on the secure website](#)).

Qualifications Wales announced on 13 May 2022 that GCSE, AS and A level adaptations made for the 2022 exams will not apply in 2023. Students resitting exams in 2023 will take the same exam paper as students sitting for the first time. There will not be a separate paper for resitting candidates based on streamlined assessment content for summer 2022.

However, advance information of the focus of the 2023 assessments will be provided in early February 2023 to help all students prioritise their revision.

All entry fees will remain at the standard fee for that qualification regardless of the adapted assessment arrangements in place. For candidates resitting WJEC A Level Art & Design from Summer 2022, the applicable entry option, and cash-in for unitised qualifications should be selected.

### 5.3 Level 3: Health and Social Care: Principles and Contexts

For January and Summer 2023 only, the resit arrangements for this qualification are as follows:

- Candidates who completed the Diploma in Summer 2022 and who wish to resit are required to resit Units 4 and/or 5 only in 2023 (unit 4 is not available in January).
- Candidates who completed the Certificate in Summer 2021 who didn't progress to the Diploma in 2022 but now want to complete the Diploma in 2023 will also only be required to complete the assessments for Units 4 and 5 only. Centres should continue to teach Unit 6 to these learners and provide the same sector engagement and work placement opportunities that are being made available to learners who are completing the Diploma in 2023.

From summer 2024, learners wishing to cash-in the Diploma must have been entered for all units (or carry forward unit UMS from an earlier series).

### 5.4 Remote Invigilation service

Fees listed for qualification entry do not include optional Remote Invigilation services for qualifications where this is available.
