

Welsh medium qualifications policy statement

WJEC is committed to providing equal qualification provision in Welsh and English

WJEC qualifications

- All of WJEC's qualifications are fully available in Welsh and English (unless the subject is Welsh or English).
- This means that the specification, sample assessment materials, live assessment materials and all supporting documentation are available in both Welsh and English.
- Live assessments are available in Welsh and centres do not need to request them prior to entering candidates for assessment.

Eduqas qualifications

- Live assessments are available in Welsh and English for all Eduqas qualifications designated by Qualifications Wales.
- WJEC annually emails all centres in Wales with a link to a form for requesting Welsh medium examination papers for the following summer series – there will be a November deadline for centres to return completed forms.
- For the following Eduqas designated qualifications, the specification and sample assessment materials are also available in both Welsh and English, meaning that the qualifications are fully available through the medium of Welsh:
 - GCSE (9-1) in Sociology
 - GCSE (9-1) in Film Studies
 - GCSE (9-1) in Electronics
 - Advanced GCE in Electronics
- For the following qualifications where there has historically been no demand from Welsh medium centres, although live assessments are available in Welsh as outlined above, the specification and/or sample assessment materials have not been previously made available in Welsh:
 - Advanced Subsidiary GCE in Electronics (specification available in Welsh)
 - GCSE (9-1) in Latin
 - GCSE (9-1) in Geology
 - Advanced Subsidiary GCE in Geology
 - Advanced GCE in Geology
 - Advanced Subsidiary GCE in Film Studies
 - Advanced GCE in Film Studies
- However, WJEC is committed to making all of its Eduqas' designated provision fully available in Welsh in future. Therefore, from September 2025, in addition to making live assessments available in Welsh, the specification and sample assessment materials will be published in Welsh on our website (unless they are qualifications that are going to be withdrawn within the next 2 years as part qualification reform).
- In future, when a new Eduqas qualification is designated by Qualifications Wales, we will make the qualification available in Welsh and English at the same time.
