1. New Resources for Teaching and Learning

All of these resources below will be available in the **Resources** tabs on the WJEC website subject pages for GCSE <u>French</u> / <u>German</u> / <u>Spanish</u> and GCE <u>French</u> / <u>German</u> / <u>Spanish</u>.

Exam Walk Throughs (EWTs)

These are a free resource for both GCSE and GCE. These comprise visual and audio Powerpoint guides to the exams, put together by our experts. They are designed with the learner in mind to be used independently as part of remote or blended learning. Equally, teachers might find it useful to use as a group activity in class.

Teaching and Learning Guides

These are free resources that have been produced by our experts as a suggested approach for using our <u>online resources</u> for teachers of French, German or Spanish. The aim is to provide comprehensive support for teachers however they might33 have to conduct their teaching and learning during the coming year.

Resource Booklets

5. CPD Autumn 2020

Modern Foreign Languages (French, German and Spanish) autumn programme

Pre-recorded Webinars (a free resource)

We have been busy producing pre-recorded webinars as training material for teachers, one for each language at GCSE and at A level. *Mark Like an Examiner for GCSE Unit 4* and *Mark Like an Examiner for GCE Units 2 and 5* provide useful information and practice materials for teachers wishing to improve their marking skills for these papers. They will be available for French, German and Spanish on the subject pages of the website and have been written by experts with an in-depth practical knowledge of these units.

Live CPD Webinars for Autumn 2020 (chargeable)

Due to the current ongoing situation, face-to-face training is not possible. However, we are providing two training opportunities during the autumn term for teachers. *Listening and Reading Resilience* for GCSE MFL teachers explores what it is, how it can help learners and how to develop it in the MFL classroom and is full of practical advice.

The second live webinar is for A Level MFL and is designed for *classroom practitioners new to teaching film and literary works*. This is a practical guide, full of advice and suggested approaches for the *novice* in their first year of teaching Unit 2 (film) and Unit 5 (literary work) at AS/A level and has been written by an experienced practitioner in these units. Although there is a modest charge for this it can be attended by the individual or accessed by a whole department.
