

1. November 2023 CPD Events



During November 2023, the engineering team delivered a series of face-to-face CPD events across the country in Newport, Manchester, and Nottingham. 2. The new 'WJEC Portal'



Our new WJEC Portal, which supersedes our Secure Website is now live. With growth in cyber security issues, 'Portal' has been designed to the highest-level security standards to safeguard all sensitive information, including learner personal data, and protect the integrity of secure and confidential assessment materials.

We have introduced Multifactor Authentication (MFA) as part of the secure login process to Portal. Authentication will be made via the Authenticator app, SMS or email depending on your preference.

We have a set of <u>FAQs</u> to support you with regards to the new 'Portal'.

3. Centre Moderation Report January 2024

If you did not enter your marks on the secure website this winter, then you will need to ask your Examinations Officer to download the report(s) or give you permission to access them on the portal.


4. Principal Examiners' Reports January 2024



Uploading of marks and candidates' work is done via <u>WJEC Portal</u>. The updated <u>subject specific</u> guidance provides useful links and outlines file naming conventions and supported file types.

Once you have inputted candidate marks for Units 1 and / or 2 via IAMIS (Portal), then you will be able to upload candidate evidence and supporting documents via the cloud that appears next to the candidate's name. This must be completed by the 5th May 2024.
