## 1. Key dates for summer 2024

The deadline for submission of internal marks to WJEC will be 31st May 2025 and the moderation window will be 2nd June – 4th July. Your allocated moderator will contact you in April to arrange the Centre visit.

# 2. Preliminary entries

You will need to make preliminary entries via <u>Portal</u> in October of the academic year of assessment so that we can dispatch the appropriate number of GCSE Assignment papers to your centre. If you are in any doubt about whether candidates will be entered for any specific subject/title, you are advised to include a small notional amount (e.g. 5) to ensure that appropriate materials are despatched to you.

If your students are to be assessed in summer 2025 you would need to prompt your Exams Officer to make the preliminary entries by 10<sup>th</sup> October 2024 which would trigger the despatch of papers to your centre in December 2024, ready for release to candidates from 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2025. Final entries should then be made by 21st February 2025.
