1. Summer 2025. The Examination timetable has been confirmed and is available on the [open website](#).
2. Electronic upload of internal assessment evidence for moderation – We will continue with this for summer 2025, and we recommend that centres upload the unit evidence as a PDF document for ease of upload and moderation. Remember the deadline date is May 15th. [IAMIS](#) will be open at the end of March if any centres are ready to input marks.

6. The Level 3 qualification is also being reviewed for teaching from September 2026

We hope to have a draft specification in place by September 2025.

The key points being considered are:

- Change the grading A *- E. This ensures equity with GCE and UCAS points
- Removal of the “workplace” emphasis – reducing VQ feel
- Certificate to become a 2 Unit qualification
- Diploma to become a 4 Unit qualification (2 optional)
- Must pass all units will be removed
- Re-sit option to still be available
- To ensure there is a year 1 exit route
