Teaching for 2025

A reminder of [key dates](#) for examinations and NEA marks and submissions.

- NEA assessments can be found in [Portal](#). There are candidate packs and assessor packs. Candidate packs should only be given to candidates once all the teaching and learning is completed.
- NEA has two windows for submission: Winter and Summer.
 - Winter deadline: **10th December Unit 2 & Unit 3 marks and uploads**
 - Summer deadline: **5th May Unit 2 & Unit 3 marks and uploads**
- All work for NEA to be uploaded to IAMIS for 2024/25 and **NOT** Surpass
- External assessment (examination) two windows (terminal rule applies)
 - Winter examination date: **Thursday 16th January**
 - Summer examination date: **Tuesday 10th June**
