

#### 1. The new 'WJEC Portal'



Our new WJEC Portal, which supersedes our Secure Website has been live since November 2023. With growth in cyber security issues, 'Portal' has been designed to the highest-level security standards to safeguard all sensitive information, including learner personal data, and protect the integrity of secure and confidential assessment materials.

We have introduced Multifactor Authentication (MFA) as part of the secure login process to Portal. Authentication will be made via the Authenticator app, SMS or email depending on your preference.

We have a set of <u>FAQs</u> to support you with regards to the new 'Portal'.

# 4. Networking Map




